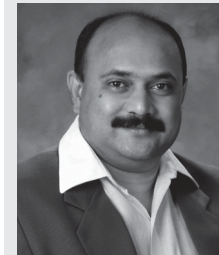
You will be happy to know that based on a new merit based procedure approved by the Council of Management of All India Management Association (AIMA) BMA had qualified to be represented at the AIMA Council for the year 2015-16. BMA was unanimously recommended for the prestigious AIMA Best Local Management Association Award 2014-15 for consistently doing excellent work in the field. BMA has been the recipient of this award 15 times, which is a record unto itself.

Educational programs form an important portion of BMA's activities. They help achieve the key objective of furthering the management movement. I am happy to share that we have signed an agreement with AIMA to offer their professional diplomas in management. This is under the aegis of The Centre for Management Education (CME), the educational arm of AIMA, which offers management education programs nation-wide by distance learning through its Study Centers spread across the country. Also on the anvil is an AICTE approved Evening MBA program along with our academic partners, Parul University.

I am happy to share that all the regular programs at BMA were executed and implemented exemplarily throughout the year – be it Management Week, Management Development Programs (MDPs), In Company Training Programs (ICTs), Certificate Courses, Workshops, Special Talks, Memorial Lectures, Industrial Visits and Movie Shows. You will find more details in the Annual Report. I would like to add here that the special emphasis on hall rentals as well as other income gave rich dividends. Our bulletin SAMANVAYA, with a new format, was well received and widely appreciated.

Among the firsts was the launch of a very special Residential MDP – Leadership Retreat – with the theme “Make in India Manager” this year (April 2016). We also had a highly successful International MDP on “Etiquette for Global Business”. We ran special certificate courses for women this year, with the ones on “The FinTelligent Woman” and “Spoken English and Personality Development for Housewives” becoming runaway successes. Our ICT on “Finance for Non-Finance Executives” was very well appreciated, as was the Special MDP on the contemporary topic of “Cyber Crime”. The workshop on “Creative Photography” was another unique milestone.

We also released our own publication this year - ‘Awakened Youth - Attitudes and Achievements’, authored by Guruji Shri G Narayana. We also had a special talk by Guruji at EME School on “Effective and Dynamic Leadership”.



Our flagship programs and mega events like the Annual Management Convention (AMC), Cooperative Seminar, Sayaji Ratna Award (SRA), Shaping Young Minds Program (SYMP), Annual Awards for Outstanding Young Managers (AAOYM), Igniting Minds-Young India (IMYI) as well as Round Table Conferences (RTCs) on Power and Human Resource Management have been widely accepted and acknowledged – powerful and resourceful. The Round Table on Power Sector had the theme “Renewable Energy”, with Hon Minister Shri Saurabhbbhai Patel delivering the keynote address. Our Mega Event, the “Annual Management Convention”, was about “Reimagining India”. Our unique program, the Co-operative Seminar, was on “Use of agriculture inputs to get maximum production of the crops”. Legendary business leader Shri Ratan Tata was presented the Sayaji Ratna Award. The “Shaping Young Minds Program” drew a very large section of the youth of Baroda, to listen to and get inspired by Brand Guru Piyush Pandey, Lokayukta Justice N Santosh Hegde and Ambassador Deepak Vohra. The 2nd Round Table on Human Resource Management, in the fond memory of our PP Dr A P Singh, had the theme ‘HR - Emerging Trends and Challenges’ and made an indelible imprint and impact. **We had two jubilees this year - the 25th AAOYM as well as the 50th SYMP.**

We have also had some extraordinary book launches. The first was “Corporate Happiness” by renowned mentor, trainer, orator and author of six bestsellers Dr.Rekha Shetty. This was followed by launch of “Chanakya in You” by best-selling author Dr. Radhakrishnan Pillai. Iconic HR Expert Prof. T.V.Rao launched his latest book “Effective People” at the HR Round Table at BMA. Celebrity Dietician Rujuta Diwekar launched her latest book at a Talk Show this year (April 2016).

On the membership front, **we added Eleven more patron members. With regular income, prudent finance management and overall program and event surpluses, we could raise our corpus by over Rs. 60 lakhs this year, up from Rs.28.88 lakhs to Rs.90.86 lakhs by the year-end. The top as well as bottom line have also been exceptional this year, with an income of Rs.107.84 lakhs and a net profit of Rs.25.77 lakhs.**

We forged some very special alliances and relationships this year. Our Card Partnership with Presidency Club gave all our members an exclusive privilege card with a host of benefits. Our Music Partner RCA added melody and rhythm to breaks within our events. Our Memento Partnership with Incredible Landscapes had all our guests receiving beautiful potted plants. Our Academic Partnership with Parul University increased our engagement and involvement with each other and substantially increased our student membership. The Corporate Sponsorship from L & T Power gave an impetus to all our programs.

A) Significant Accounting Policies:

1) Basis of Preparation of Financial Statements :

The Association generally follows accrual system of accounting, except in case of membership subscription which is accounted on cash basis. Membership received in advance is shown as liability.

2) Investments:

Investments are stated at cost.

3) Fixed Assets & Depreciation:

Fixed assets are stated at written down value less current year's depreciation at the rates and in the manner depending on estimated life of the assets.

B) Notes on Accounts:

1) In the opinion of the Managing Committee, the Balances shown under the current assets have a realizable value in the ordinary course of activities of the Association at least equal to the amounts at which they are shown in the Balance Sheet.

2) The Total Expenditure of the Association during the year is Rs. 82,07,873/- and the Total Income is Rs. 1,07,84,928/-, resulting into a Total Surplus (Excess of Income Over Expenditure) of Rs. 25,77,055/-.

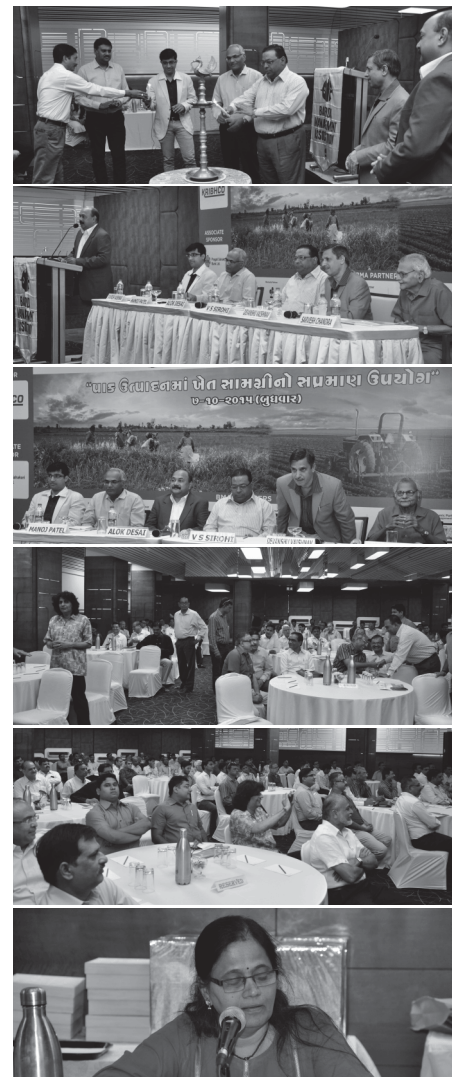

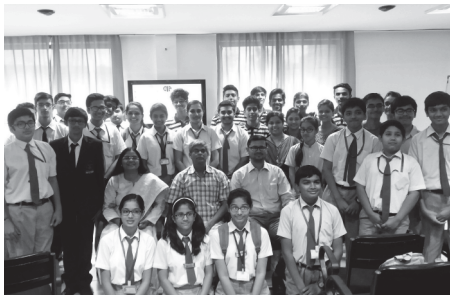
