Leadership through Emotional Intelligence

Date: 8th September 2021

About Topic:

Emotional Intelligence (EI) refers to the ability to perceive, control, and evaluate emotions. Some researchers suggest that emotional intelligence can be learned and strengthened, while others claim it's an inborn characteristic.



A Full day MDP was organized on 8th September 2021 at the Taj Vivanta by BMA steered by Mr. Rajesh Jain a Corporate coach from the UK. The intensive workshop was attended by few people who were deeply interested in the subject and remained in the various games etc.

The MOC Ms. Shivani Mathur started the MDP by introducing about Baroda Management Association and then introduced the **President of BMA, Mr. Dipak Shah**. He formally welcomed the speaker Mr. Rajesh Jain and all the participants.

Mr. Jain had organized a meaningful and engaging session on emotional intelligence and started by asking the attendees to be more self-aware. Using several techniques, questionnaires, and games, he engaged the audience and led them to the awareness that emotions need management. Covering a spectrum of topics, right from interpersonal relations, conflict resolution, negative emotions, ego and anxiety, communication and maintaining a positive and calm approach.

He spoke about 7 spiritual laws of success, i.e. Law of pure potentially, Law of Giving, Law of Karma, Law of least effort, Law of intention and desire, Law of detachment and Law of dharma. He also explained the skills of self motivation. Cultivating an empathetic personality through a harmonious and co operative work culture and creating spiritual awareness. Jain explained the laws of success and using the Maslow's motivation model he gave the following tips:



1. Tips for self motivation approach for success

- ❖Treasure moments of success and achievement and visualize it for self-motivation.
- ❖ Be physically fit, take good diet and sound sleep.
- ❖ Develop at least one hobby.
- ❖ Attach yourself with great mission in life.

2. Approach for Success

- ❖Flexible & able to let go.
- ❖ Always purposeful in thinking and actions.
- Proactively maintains life vs. work balance.
- ❖ Excellent in social skills.
- Always concern for personal development.
- Use discipline opportunity to change team's behavior.
- ❖ Provide safe and caring environment.

Participants has also shared their experience of attending this MDP and were very thankful to BMA team to organize such an intense workshop on a much-needed topic. Lastly Mr. Kalpesh Shah Hon. 


