The one day training program focused on familiarizing participants with the skills and knowledge to use Data Analytics to drive strategic decision making along with operational improvements in business.



The course included introduction to Business Data Analytics, relevance of Business Data Analytics with real life applications, the different levels of Analytics - Application of Descriptive Analytics, Predictive Analytics and Prescriptive Analytics. Using that laptops during the practical session the participants got hands on experience also.

#### **Leading The Way - During Difficult Times**

It is said that the role of a great leader gets even more pronounced during a crisis as employees look up to them for assurance and guidance. HR managers confirm that leadership planning is always high on the corporate agenda.

According to Peter Drucker effective leadership is not about making speeches or being liked. Leadership is defined by results and not attributes. This becomes even more crucial during a crisis situation when people in leadership roles are expected to go beyond being just leaders and inspire their team to rise above the challenges. Employees expect leaders to help them identify opportunities and leverage them. They expect to be coached about the changing demands and rules. Also employees expect their leaders to trust them and enable them to develop their competencies.

The Management's policies and HR policies must not be different in difficult times and normal times, except that in tough times the leader has to be more visible within the organisation. One major function of the leader during such times is to communicate more and more then what he or she would be doing otherwise. A leader has to communicate more frequently and has to reach out to the employees and seek inputs from them on what is happening at the ground level.

During the difficult situation the fear of uncertainty brings in a lot of anxiety. Thus within an organisation a capable leader must be in a place to ward of this anxiety and boost the confidence level. Experts feel that sharing information and data with the employees alone cannot reduce the stress, employees must have confidence in their leaders and they must feel safe under their leadership. This confidence and trust has to be built up over time and cannot happen overnight at the time of a crisis.

Apart from effective communication some of the most effective ways of motivating the workforce during challenging times are to appraise the workforce about the development within an outside the organisation to bring about consistency in objectives, be available and listen to problems of the work force, acknowledge their concerns even if addressing them is a difficult proposition and appreciate employees for work well done.

Working out from the ivory tower is the last thing that any leader should do during a crisis. A leader must reach out to the people and must be easily accessible.

As per industry experts another key area that a leader should focus on during tough times is to concentrate more on the values and culture of an organisation. Focusing on long term goals and building a competent talent pool for the future is imperative as it is said a good leader must be a visionary who not only thinks about today's challenges but also about the opportunities and future.
