Date: January 05, 2024 | Speaker: Dr. Nilesh Shah





In Friday Evening talk on  $5^{\text{th}}$  of January the speaker was Dr. Nilesh Shah, aeminent Anesthesiologist of the city. Dr. Nilesh Sir explained how a non-medical person can timely save somebody's life by giving chest compression,He explained the entire concept in three simple steps which were,

- (1) Early recognition & activation
- (2) Early chest compression&
- (3) Early transfer

Dr. Shah emphasised that it's their Mission to see that there is atleast one person in every house who has the knowledge of Chest Compression so that more and more lives can be saved by timely bystander intervention.

Dr. Alpa Shah, a well-known Senior Obstetrician and Gynecologist of the city, was speaker in FET wherein, Dr. Alpa

explained how is the Women Life Cycle and what all types of Hormonal changes a Female experience from the time of her menarche till the time of her menopause. She also created an awareness by busting myths and offering lifestyle advice on prevalent and concerning issues like PCOS. She even revealed some significant ways on how a women can deal with the body pains and changes that occur during the reproductive years and post menopause. Later she elaborated that how in today's generation the junk food is causing health issues.

# Prevention is Better than Cure-Know Your Numbers

Sanket Saraiya, a well k n o w n Consultant interventional Cardiologist & Director at Nidaan Heart, in Gotri, Vadodara was the speaker. He explained that what is the reason behind the blockage that is caused in the arteries, he said that when you see nowadays



that so many people are suffering from heart attack irrespective of their age, he said that, it is all dependent on our day to day life as in, how is our life style and what all we consume and what sort of exercise we are performing that leaves a direct impact on our Health. He also revealed that natural death that are caused in the accidents are mostly due to heart attacks. Later, He said that ageing is the most common factor where a person suffers from a heart attack and that is something that is non-modifiable and he said that it is the most common reason for heart attacks. Comparing to the gender, he said that when a female is at her menopausal period, at that point there are high chances that she might suffer from a heart attack and that risk are even more when it is compared to males. He emphasized on healthy lifestyle, proper nutrition, exercise and monitoring BPfor early detection of heart related ailments.

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# Preventive Cancer Care And Signs to Look For Early Detection

speaker was Dr. Niraj Bhatt, an eminent oncologist of Vadodara. He is known for his exceptional expertise in this field with an impressive career spanning more than 20 years. He talked on the subject "Cancer-Alert Today, Alive Tomorrow." He explained, what cancer cells are and how when they grow due to certain reasons in the Body, which causes the deadly disease, Cancer. He further explained that, cancer was recognized when tobacco was discovered and it is flourishing because of the unhealthy lifestyle. He explained that cancer is the uncontrolled cell division which grows and formulates a lump (Tumor) or say large number of abnormal white cells in the blood and it mutates the cell that is viewed by the Immune System and later spreads within the body and survives in another parts of the body. He further explained how different types of cancer in Body develops and what are the preventive measures for the same. He even said that 80% of cancers are caused due to unhealthy lifestyle. He emphasized how regular exercise helps in avoiding unnecessary invites to diseases such as hypertension, Diabetes etc. He explained the difference between Level 1, 2 and advanced level of cancer. He elaborated what are the warning signs of cancer and how they can be treated with early diagnosis by FNAC, Trucut Biopsy, Punch Biopsy, PAP Smear, Mammography Pet Scan etc. There are so many myths about this disease that Dr. Bhatt condemned and explained that they are not true. He concluded that early detection is a key to curing Cancer and following a healthy lifestyle, avoiding junk food, and after a certain age periodic scanning will definite prevent the disease or assist in curing the disease. He emphasized that Prevention is definitely better than Cure.

She even said how are Hr Metrics are used to determine the value and effectiveness of Hr initiatives by typically including areas like turnover, training, return on human capital, expenses per employee by further stating types of metrics.
